SATS Results

We are extremely proud of all our children across the school for working so hard and making good progress this year. Thank you also to all our teachers and support staff across the school for running so many booster and challenge groups before and after school. Our results at the end of every key stage, and in the Year 1 phonics screening were significantly above provisional national figures. Our pupils also did extremely well in the Year 4 times tables check. Our Year 6 pupils achieved impressive SATs results, bucking the national trend of a significant dip in achievement. We hope that they can see that their hard work, dedication and determination has paid off!
