Message from Mr Reisman

From next week we will be awarding children in our assemblies for showing amazing qualities in PE and school sport. Two children in each key stage will receive one of our 'Me in PE' certificates for showing particular qualities in the following areas.

Physical ME Certificate -

Showing excellent development or performance of physical and technical skills linked to PE.

Social ME Certificate

Showing excellent qualities of teamwork, organisation, sporting values and working with others during PE.

Thinking ME Certificate

Showing analysis creativity through ideas, strategies, tactics, composition and evaluation in PE sessions.

This is ME Certificate

Showing traits of resilience, challenge, leadership and dealing with winning and losing through PE.

All these 4 areas fit in with the different goals of our PE curriculum as we look to support students develop these wider skills that can be applied across subjects and areas of life outside of school. To support this, we want to recognise and celebrate children who have managed to achieve in one of these areas during PE each week. Certificates may be selected by the PE team or teachers involved in the delivery of PE.
