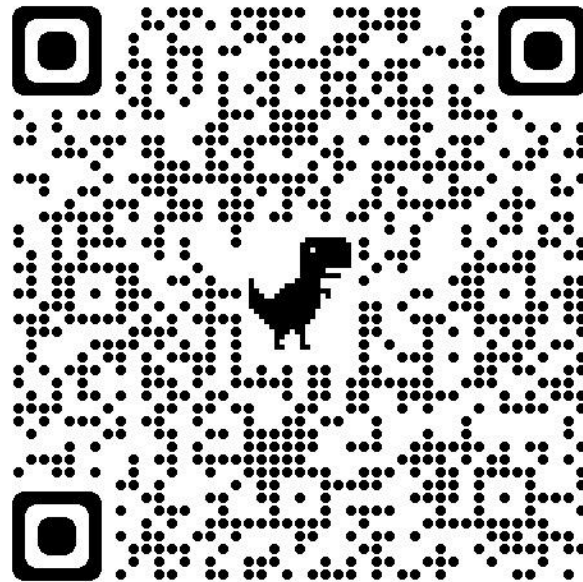
## Food Bank
