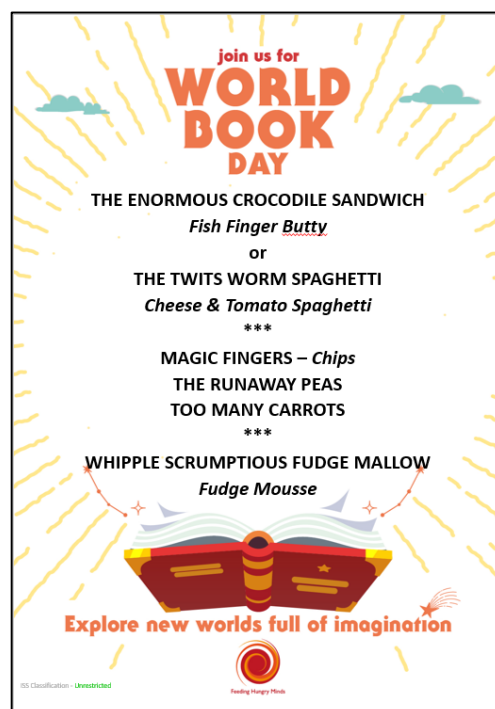
A polite reminder from us is that teachers may not access, and will not respond to, messages sent via Class Dojo or Tapestry.
