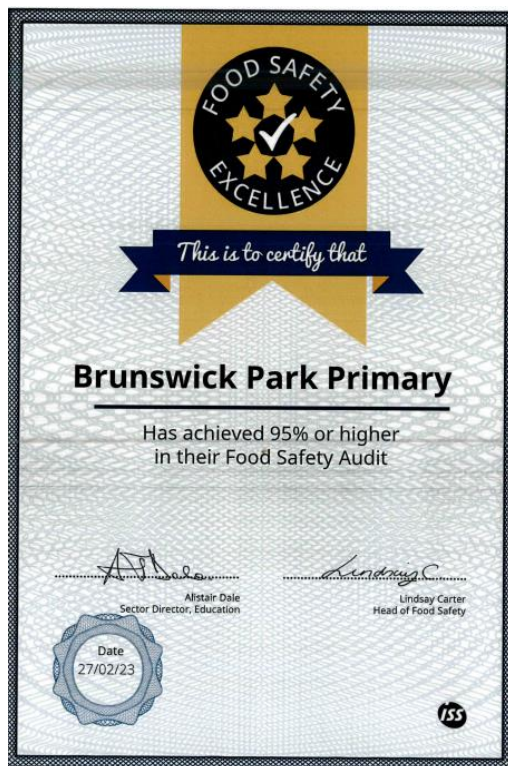
National Emergency Alert Test
