


English

We will be writing:

We will be reading a book of poetry called 'A Kid in my Class' by Rachael Rooney. The children will be writing and performing their own poetry focusing on rhyming schemes, tone of voice, volume, rhythm of speech, tempo, movement and facial expressions.



Maths

We will also be focusing on:

- Decimals
- Money
- Time

Children will also continue to develop their understanding of the formal written methods of the four operations.

Science

Our science topic this half term is Sound.

Our Big Question is:

How do we hear different sounds?

We will be exploring:

- How sounds are made
- Recognise that vibrations of sound travel through different mediums
- Pitch of sound
- Patterns between the volume of sound and the strength of vibrations.

RE

We will be learning about Judaism

Our Big Question is:

What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?

We will be reading 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' by Joe Todd-Stanton



History

Our Big Question is:

What was the struggle between the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings?

Children will learn about:

The Vikings and the Anglo Saxons struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. They will also learn about Britain's settlement by Anglo Saxons and Scots.

Art

In Art and Design, the children will be learning to draw in one-point perspective, understanding how this perspective can improve the proportions of our drawings. Children will be learning the rules of one-point perspective before creating their own masterpiece.

We will also be putting the finishing touches to our moving rainforest animals.

PE

This half term we are focusing on the following skills:

Track, Catch, Throw

Children will develop their accuracy and consistency when tracking a ball, explore a variety of throwing techniques and learn to select the appropriate throw for the situation. They will develop catching with one and two hands as well as dribbling with feet and hands.

French

We will learn about common habitats, and animals and plants that live in these habitats.
