

Brunswick Park Primary and Nursery School Autumn 1 in Year 1



We will be writing:

Narrative texts (retelling & based on familiar story)

Puffin Peter (Petr Horáček), Knuffle Bunny (Mo Willems)

We will be developing these SPaG skills: Use capital letters, full stops and spaces between words.



We will be learning:

Place value within 10 (sorting & counting objects, counting on from any number, ordering & comparing numbers).

We will be following the CPA approach (Concrete Pictorial Abstract). Children will be encouraged to follow the "Build it, Draw it, Write it, Say it" model when working with numbers.



We will be learning about Christianity.

Our Big Question is: Was it always easy for Jesus to show friendship?

This links to our previous learning on Christmas, Easter and other celebrations in Reception.



Black History Month: We are celebrating the contribution of Black people in our society. We are reading "Coming to England" by Floella Benjamin.

Our project is: Toys Past & Present

Our Big Question is: What kind of toys do you think you would see in a toy museum?

We will be learning about what toys were like at different times in the past.

We are working like historians by developing and using these skills: Understand historical concepts such a change and continuity and to identify similarities and differences.



Children will bring home a free choice book from the book corner for reading for pleasure and also a phonetically decodable book that they can read to you. These will be changed weekly. They will also be assigned a phonetically decodable e-book weekly to read at home.

We will have a whole class story time every day in addition to the books we are reading in our English lessons.



In art with Mrs. Spencer we will be looking at the work of abstract artist Wassily Kandinsky to explore the world of colour mixing. Children will use different brush strokes to carefully paint patterned lines expressing themselves in the style of work by Kandinsky and create concentric circle painting, using primary colours and secondary colours they have mixed.



This half term we are developing fundamental movement skills, becoming increasingly competent and confident to extend our agility, balance and coordination, individually and with others.



We will be developing our understanding of technology and how it can help us. We will become more familiar with the different components of a computer by developing our keyboard and mouse skills, and also start to consider how to use technology responsibly.
