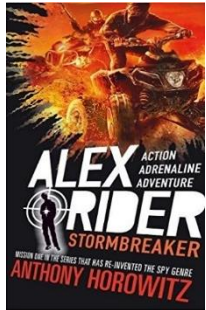
Beliefs in Practise - Buddhism
