the food we eat?




We will be learning about: Islam

This term children will learn about the Islamic pilgrimage, Hajj.

The children will be focusing on key vocabulary relating to 'Family'.



Our Big Question is:

Why is it important to protect the rainforest and how can this be done?
What is daily life like in different parts of Brazil?

Children will look at the location of Brazil and find out about the climate, push and pull factors of migration, the indigenous people, and urban and rural features.



In art, the children will be exploring Henri Rousseau's Tiger in a Tropical Storm. They will be looking at the vibrant and surreal painting before recreating their own visual tale of a dangerous night in a lush green forest.



This half term we are focusing on the following skills:

This unit has an important focus on the children's movement skills within gymnastics.

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The children will be continuing with their flute or clarinet lessons.

Children will create programs by planning, modifying, and testing commands to create shapes and patterns.
