We will be writing:

We will be writing a narrative and a non-chronological report based on this text. For our narrative we will be writing a prequel to the story explaining how the Iron man came to be. Our non-chronological report will be based on our topic- The Vikings.



Maths

History

Our Big Question is:

What was the struggle between the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings?

Children will learn about:

The Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. They will also learn about Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots.

Art

In our art project this term, children will complete their Dragon Eye topic with a Clay Dragon's Eye, using intricate features they model and attach themselves. Later in the term, children will be learning to draw in one-point perspective, understanding how this perspective can improve the proportions of their drawings. Children will be learning the rules of one-point perspective before creating their own masterpiece.
