

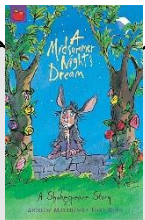
English

We will be writing:

We will be writing a narrative based on The Iron Man where we will write a prequel to the story explaining how the Iron man came to be. Our non-chronological report will be based on our topic- The Vikings.



We will be reading 'A Midsummer Night's Dream', retold by Andrew Matthews.



French

We will be able to describe different weather forecasts and will learn the compass points.

Maths

We will also be focusing on:

- Geometry: Shape
- Statistics
- Geometry: Position and Direction

Children will also continue to develop their understanding of the formal written methods of the four operations.

History

Our Big Question is:

What was the struggle between the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings?

Children will learn about:

The Vikings and the Anglo Saxons struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. They will also learn about Britain's settlement by Anglo Saxons and Scots.

Science

Our science topic this half term is Electricity.

Our Big Question is:
Can we control Electricity?

We will be exploring:

- What electricity is and where it comes from
- Some common appliances and identifying whether they require mains or battery powered electricity
- Electrical series circuits and the components required
- Some conductors and insulators of electricity and what this means.

Art

We will be learning to draw in 1 point perspective, understanding how this perspective can improve the proportions of our drawings. Children will be learning the rules of one-point perspective before creating their own masterpiece.

RE

We will be learning about: Judaism

Our Big Question is:

What is the best way for those who follow the Jewish faith to show commitment to God?
